

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Editor's Desk

In March this year, we had organized the first Sai Sandhya in Frankfurt at a devotees' home. A humble start was made. The motivation was simple - to connect with fellow devotees of Shri Sai living in Europe and other parts of the world.

But little did we realize that the small start will gradually evolve into a movement. In 6 months, Sai sandhyas have been organised in 7 countries (Germany, France, Finland, Sweden, Poland, Belgium and Austria) and 10 different European cities (Frankfurt, Hamburg, Helsinki, Tampere, Paris, Stockholm, Warsaw, Brussels, Vienna and Munich). Guru Poornima was also celebrated in Finland, where many devotees came and received the blessings of Shri Sai. Dussehra will be celebrated in a huge way in Frankfurt - artists will come to sing bhajans along with classical dance performances and painting competition for children. A similar event will also be organised in Finland.

This raises a pertinent question, which we are often asked - how is all this happening? What's the force behind this? The answer is simple. It is the divine blessings and love of Shri Sai, which has helped us to successfully organize such events. We had started as a group on Facebook - Shri Shirdi Sai Baba (International), which now has over 1500 members based in Europe, US, Canada, South America, Africa and other parts of the world. In view of the increasing number of devotees, we recently created a website (www.shrisaibaba.net) so that a larger number of devotees can easily access information about the events. Also, the website has original photographs of Shri Sai and scanned copies of Shri SaiSatcharita. In addition, a YouTube Channel (Shri Sai Baba) has been created where videos of events across Europe are being shared -

Gradually a number of foreign devotees are contacting us with queries about Shri Sai. With the objective of the Master's teachings reaching to not only English speaking people, we have started releasing flyers with His quotes, in different languages like German, Spanish, English and may be more languages in future.

We hope that by 2017, we have events relating to Shri Sai in all major European countries. Let's all come together and spread the humanistic values of love and brotherhood.

In addition, we are also keen to organise activities by which help can be provided to poor and needy people. Earlier this year, some money had been collected which was sent to Nepal to provide aid to those affected by earthquake. We pray to Shri Sai to bless us so that we are able to organise more such activities in future.

I am grateful to all the devotees for sending articles, sharing their experiences, poems and making beautiful sketches for our magazine. I also thank Ankur, my friend for many years, who is always there to help me with the flyers for the various events and has again helped me with the formatting and styling of this magazine.

Maha Samadhi Message


A human being is basically an animal. He belongs to the Homo Sapiens group of primates. Homo Sapiens have been defined as the species of bi-pedal primates. Modern man belongs to this species and is characterised by a brain capacity averaging 1400 CC and by dependence upon language and the creation and utilisation of complex tools - the only surviving hominid. How is the human being different or superior to other animals? The question is whether our cognitive abilities differ from those of other animals in kind or in degree or in both. Charles Darwin held that, otherwise similar, human beings are incrementally more intelligent than other animals due to the process of evolution. However, some research findings assert that basically there exists a profound gap between our intellect and that of the animals.

Why do the animals behave in the manner they do and how is it different from human behaviour? The real secret of how animals are born with the knowledge of how to do things or behave in a certain manner seems to be a mystery. However, they possess 'innate behaviour'. Such an 'innate behaviour'does not have to be taught or practised. It is an activity that an animal knows from birth. It can be said that 'innate behaviour' is nothing but a part of animals' DNA make-up. However, sometimes they can be taught 'learned behaviour' through formal training e.g., as in the case of the circus animals. These behaviours are passed down from one generation to the next through the genes. Human behaviour is mostly, the outcome of an adopted mind. Adoption means adopt from the environment and the prevailing culture. The consciousness of an animal, other than the human beings, is instinctive consciousness whereas that of human beings is intellectual consciousness. Through his adopted culture, the human being is able to control the propulsions of his instinct at will. Unlike an animal, he doesn't always react to instinctive motivations. The three strongest common instinctive behaviours of both animals and human beings relate to hunger, anger and sex. The study of human behaviour has aptly proven that when a man is severely inflicted with any of these three motivations, he behaves no better than an animal. In such a state of mind, he is capable of inflicting grievous violence like murder, rape or robbery on others.

Anger, if not controlled, has all the potentialities of leading to violence and committing of crime. Usually, physical violence is a result of a state of mental violence. A person may seem to be extremely polite and calm in his external behaviour but may be nourishing a lot of mental violence within. There are examples of many people who committed major crimes like murder and repented later. This is indicative of the fact that they were not aware about the burning amber of violence within their mind. Such persons are prone to find

fault and imperfection in others without realising their own deficiencies. A large number of such persons develop mental and neuro diseases because they live in a virtual world of hatred, jealousy, revenge and inflated ego. They need serious counselling. That is why, the Vedic culture and the wise advised for the control and suppression of mental violence. The entire Indian Culture as propounded by the Seers and the Gurus has been programmed to develop this state of mental equipoise through Yogic practices, meditation and various other methods. It is said that a man who is capable of controlling his mind is capable of controlling everything.

May we always strive to shun hatred and violence.

(ii) The first Sai Sandhya in Vienna, Austria, was held on September 27, 2015. Please see below the pictures -




Vienna was the 10th city and Austria the 7th country in Europe, where, with the blessings of Shri Sai, we have been able to organize an event this year.


(iii) On 1st August 2015, Guru Poornima was celebrated in Finland. A large number of devotees attended the event. Some pictures are below -



When Baba helped me with my job

I am from Hyderabad, now living in Spain. I was born on Thursday and with that started my attachment with Shri Sai Baba. Every important result in my life, no matter what, has been on a Thursday and I am sure it will always be like this. I just believe in Him unconditionally. Here I want to share a life changing experience with Shri Sai Baba.

I belonged to a lower-middle class family from India .I wanted to study abroad. I have a three-year degree from India which doesn't support me to get an admission in popular countries. Also, I was not having enough funds to finance my studies. My father owns a house which was bought on a loan from LIC financial institution. That is the ONLY source for my higher education. But the thing is, since it's already in a "home loan", most of the banks said they cannot process for an "educational loan" as it becomes a second charge against a single property.

I had no idea as to how to move forward at this juncture. I visited Shirdi for peace of mind. Later, I got in touch with an overseas educational consultancy which showed me a way to get admission in Spain. Eventually a bank agreed to "Take over" the home loan from LIC and issue another educational loan which finances my full tuition fees and also living expenses. I know something of this kind would happen because I just believed in Him unconditionally.

Spanish student visa process is one of toughest and maximum documentation is required. I got over it and I got Visa approval on Thursday. I came to Spain but the economic situation in Spain is not so good. Unemployment rate is over 29 %, very difficult to get a job even for locals. However, I prayed at Shri Sai's Holy Feet and did everythingthat I could do to find a job. Finally I got a job in which I am happy now.

Whatever happens to you, happens for a reason!! Believe in Shri Sai Baba and he will take care of you!!

I have many experiences until now but the one which has truly surprised me was the following one.

It was May 2010, I met with an accident and suffered an injury on my coccyx. Immediately, I along with my husband went to nearby emergency hospital as it was Sunday and in Paris it's very difficult to find a doctorduring the weekend. They checked me and told me that your coccyx has got hurt. I was having lot of pain and wasn't able to sit also.


The doctor prescribed me heavy dose painkiller after every four hours. I wasn't able to sleep that night and then for the following few nights. I used to cry a lot and was feeling low. I had just finished doing my navguruvarvrat before one week of accident and was thinking that why Sai Baba has done this to me but on second thought I felt Saibaba is always there with me and He knows what is good for me and I have full faith on Him and you won't believe it the pain was less from that very moment even after not taking painkillers.

Within 15 days I was able to stand and walk on stairs and could perform my daily routine work. We had booked our summer vacations in Spain which I thought I won't be able to go but with Baba's grace it was my most memorable trip of mine until now. Nobody who has seen me can believe that I was perfectly fine and as fit as nothing had happen to me.

The doctor had warned me that during my pregnancy I will face problem due to this injury as normally women experience backache but in my case my whole pregnancy went smoothly without any pain and I had normal delivery

and gave birth to a healthy boy. During my pregnancy and during the time of my delivery I took name of Sai Baba and Baba never left me.

I am so happy that Baba has always taken care of me. Sometimes He just tests our patience but He always takes care of His devotees. Sai Baba, if you are there for me ever I don't need anything as you are everything to me.

Once the panel members are convinced and satisfied with the initial data and results of 8 months of research work, then only they approve to carry the research further or else the research work will be terminated. This whole procedure is called as "Proposal Defense"

I was well prepared but as the defense date started coming closer I started getting bit stressed and nervous, just worrying that whether everything will go fine or not. Then I prayed to my Sai Baba, who is my strength, my courage and my everything asking that if everything has to go fine please give me a hint in the form of you (Sai Baba) coming to my home.

But then the very next moment I thought how that is possible and this is just stupid and too demanding. Then I just forgot about this demand of mine from Baba but as very truly said that Baba always keeps His promises even if we forget and so it happened.

Just 2 days before of my defense date (which was on 4.09.2014), one of our friends invited us for evening tea as the couple were leaving Bremen and going to Denmark as they got a job there. I was not very willing to go as I had my defense after 2 days and so much was there to study. Hence, I told my husband to attend the tea party at their place alone as I cannot join him. But he convinced me, telling me that we will not spend much of our time at their place and will come back to our home very soon.

I somehow unwillingly agreed to visit them in the evening. We went there, had a nice evening but the surprising part came after that when my friend told me that as we are leaving in 2-3 days to Denmark and there are still so many things which they cannot carry so they are giving some stuffs to other friends.

She told I wanted to give few things to you as well. I said that's fine for me. She gave me some general household stuffs (like sauce, bread etc.) but apart from that the unbelievable gift which I got from her was Baba's original picture on which it was written that "My blessings are always there with you and so please do not worry my child". It was like a dream for me to get Baba's picture with such a lovely message.

Then I remembered all of a sudden about my wish where I asked Baba to come to my home and bless me for my defense and no wonder how Baba kept His promise and came to my home just 2 days before my defense.

I felt like crying out of joy and then I felt very light as if all my stress and nervousness has gone. I cannot describe in words how much blessed I felt at that point of time.

On the day of my defense (04.09.2014), I was pretty casual and was not feeling any stress or nervousness. My defense day was Thursday, the most auspicious day for me, as it is my lovely Baba's day.

When I started my presentation in my defense, I presented my results and data very confidently and everything went so smooth and proper. After the presentation got over, the panel of scientists applauded and looked very happy. Then the audience and the speaker (me) were asked to leave the room as they had to discuss and then announce my result.

We all came out and I was pretty confident that I have done quite okay. To my surprise within 5 minutes the panel members opened the door and announced very happily my result telling that I have done a great job and the results of the research work are impressive enough to carry my Ph.D. research further. My joy knew no bounds and I thanked my Baba from the bottom of my heart for making this possible.

Baba I beg you please never leave us alone, forgive our mistakes or punish us for those mistakes but please never ever leave us. We cannot walk without you. Love you more than everything in this world.

Hello Sai Baba followers and strong believers. I have already shared some posts earlier and do read every day (when time permits) the experiences of other devotees about how they have also been blessed by Shri Sai. I am sharing two more experiences which I had in my life.

Experience 1

I stay abroad since many years and have been working for more than 10 years for the same company and have been always a hard worker and acquired knowledge, respect from my colleagues, senior management. One fine morning my boss came to me and told that he is leaving the department and taking another role. I felt very bad because we were working really close and I was his substitute when he was not around for the team.

But he also recommended me as his successor, but it was not on paper. He just talked about this with the senior management and everybody agreed. However, soon the senior management of the company changed. Either the new senior manager did not know or whatever else the reason may be, I did not get this position. Needless to say I was frustrated.

Then I thought Shri Sai is having a better plan for me and I chose to remain quiet. One week later I came to know that the new manager who had been appointed is younger than me and has no knowledge about this subject. I also came to know that he is very ill tempered and thought it will be very difficult to work with him. I was not willing to work with him.

So one day my senior manager called me and explained to me why he was not willing to give me the position. But he offered me some other position which is actually not promotion in the monetary terms, but in terms of responsibility, it was a higher position. My management was only checking if I can manage also other topics which are new to me to test my qualifications, skills knowledge and leadership and the time was very hard for me because everything was new but I left everything on my Shri Sai. After about a year and a half,my company announced organizational change where I expected that I will get a manager position. But even this time I didn't make it and they told that our department will be closed as our tasks are no more necessary. This was the toughest time for me. For six months there was no work. I was really frustrated and asked Shri Sai if what he has given me is the right thing.

In the meanwhile, my previoussenior manager called me and asked me to present myself before the Executive Leadership (as that was the talent review meeting), which I did. After twomonths, I got a call from other department manager, who was also present in the same meeting where I had presented myself. She had liked my skills and presentation and offered me theposition of a manager. I was very happy because this was on Thursday when she called me. From that time all things which happened - the complete approval of my position from top management until my joining the new team was all on Thursdays. So when I look back, I can say that Shri Sai always has a better plan for everybody. We need to believe in Him, deeply and strongly. When the right time comes, He will arrange everything for you.

Keep faith and be patient!

Experience 2:

Once Udi and Prasad which we had brought from Shirdi was almostover. We had planned to Shirdi in a year. So basically it meant that there will be no Udi or Prasad for a year. I told my wife that to not worry, as Shri Saiwill do something about it. He will never leave us alone.

We have some friends who are also devotees of Shri Sai Baba. They went to India and brought some Udi and Prasad for us, but when we met them they gave us only Prasad and one CD of Sai Baba, which I had also asked to bring, but in the packet there was no Udi. I asked them where is Udi.

They told we forgot to bring but we have Udi at home and when we meet next we will give. Six months passed, we met them many times but every time either we forgot to ask or they forgot to give us. One day when we realized that Udi with us was about to get over, I told them to bring Udi. Then they brought Udi and to my surprise there were 3 packets and 10 photos of Shri Sai Baba with the pose where he leans against the wall and Bhagat Mhalsapathi holds the umbrella! What a divineleela of Shri Sai Baba.

Now we had Udi but didn't have Prasad. I tried to get through internet but then I thought will it be good by the time it comes to me via post or courier. Suddenly my in-laws decided to visit us abroad. My wife asked her parents to bring Prasad but there was not time to visit Shirdi. But there is a Sai Baba temple near to their house. They went there, bought a packet of Prasad, kept it before the HolyFeet of Baba and then they brought the Prasad for us.

Always believe whatever happens, happens for good because either He wants to see in our life a big change or He wants us to be stronger and more human. I have heard the following somewhere (in Hindi):



Life without the Guru is like sleeping with your eyes open,


Oh Sai! Thanks for your mercy for waking me up from this slumber and for this token,

With only tears


